Subject: RFP for Asia Pacific

Dear SAG colleagues,

We wanted to keep you updated on the latest developments regarding the implementation of the ECHO funds in particular the Regional Focal Point (RFP) for Asia Pacific in conflict situations.

As you will remember from our meeting on the 27 March, the SAG decided that the Regional Focal Point for Asia Pacific would be shared between Australian RC (natural disasters) and CARE (conflict) pending final confirmation from CARE. CARE have confirmed that they will not be hosting that Regional Focal Point. CARE had already alerted that this could happen, so we thank them for having tried.

We have gone back to the original expressions of interest and have contacted the other organizations which expressed interest in hosting this RFP: IOM and ACTED. By COB tomorrow they will confirm if they are still willing to host that position. We would like to propose you the **following process to define which organization will host the RFP for Asia Pacific (conflict):**

- If only one of these organizations (IOM or ACTED) is still interested in hosting the position, we propose that this organization implements this activity instead of CARE.
- If both organizations are interested in hosting the position, the Support Team will prepare a recommendation based on the criteria agreed at our meeting on the 6 March. This recommendation will be shared with SAG members by email Thursday morning with a deadline of COB Friday for objections. We hope we can agree to a decision by email before the end of this week.

Please let us know by mid-day Geneva time tomorrow Wednesday 24 if any of you have any objections to this process or would like to suggest any other alternatives.

As both IOM and ACTED are already implementing other activities in the ECHO funding, the current administrative process between would not be significantly delayed.
