

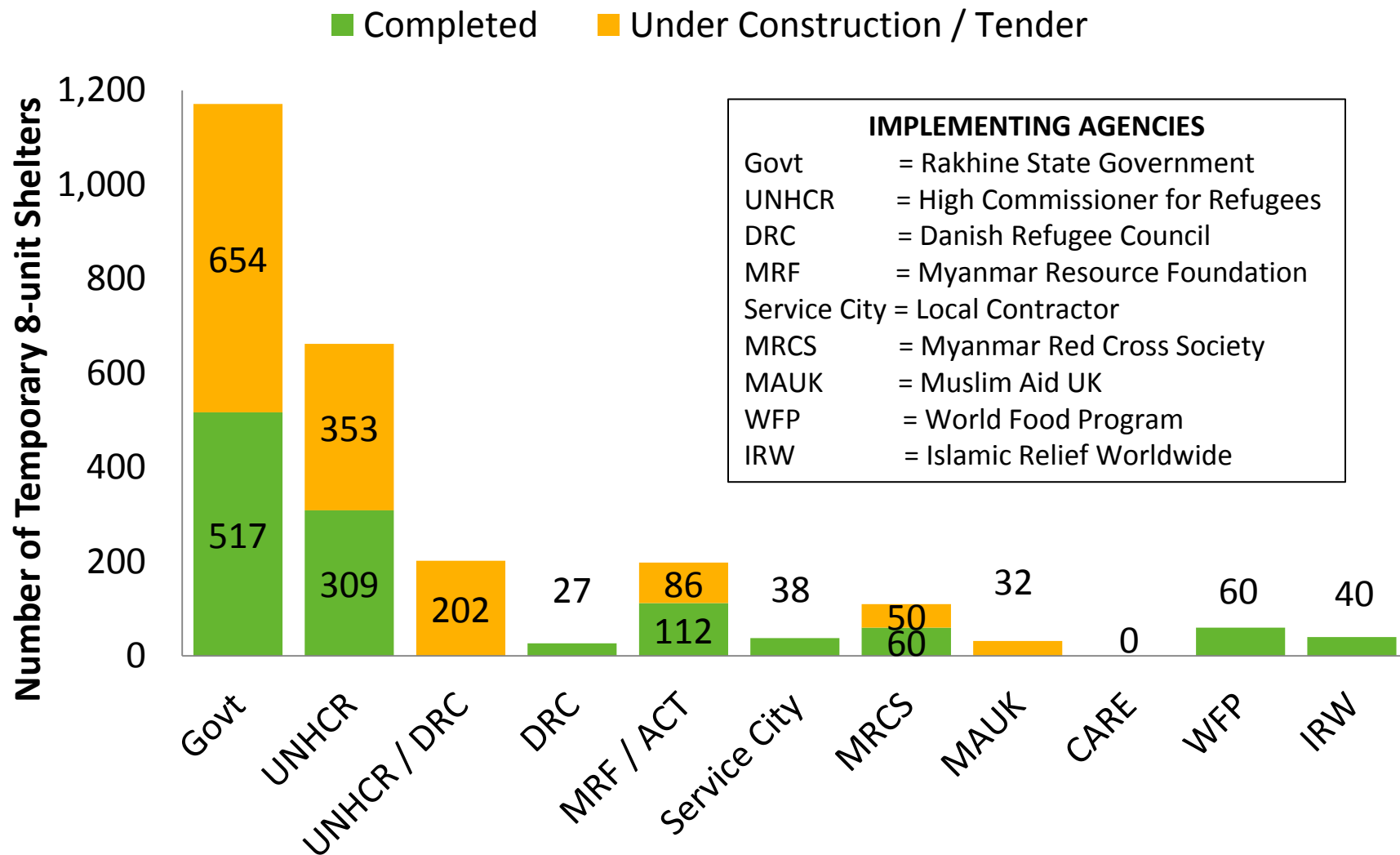

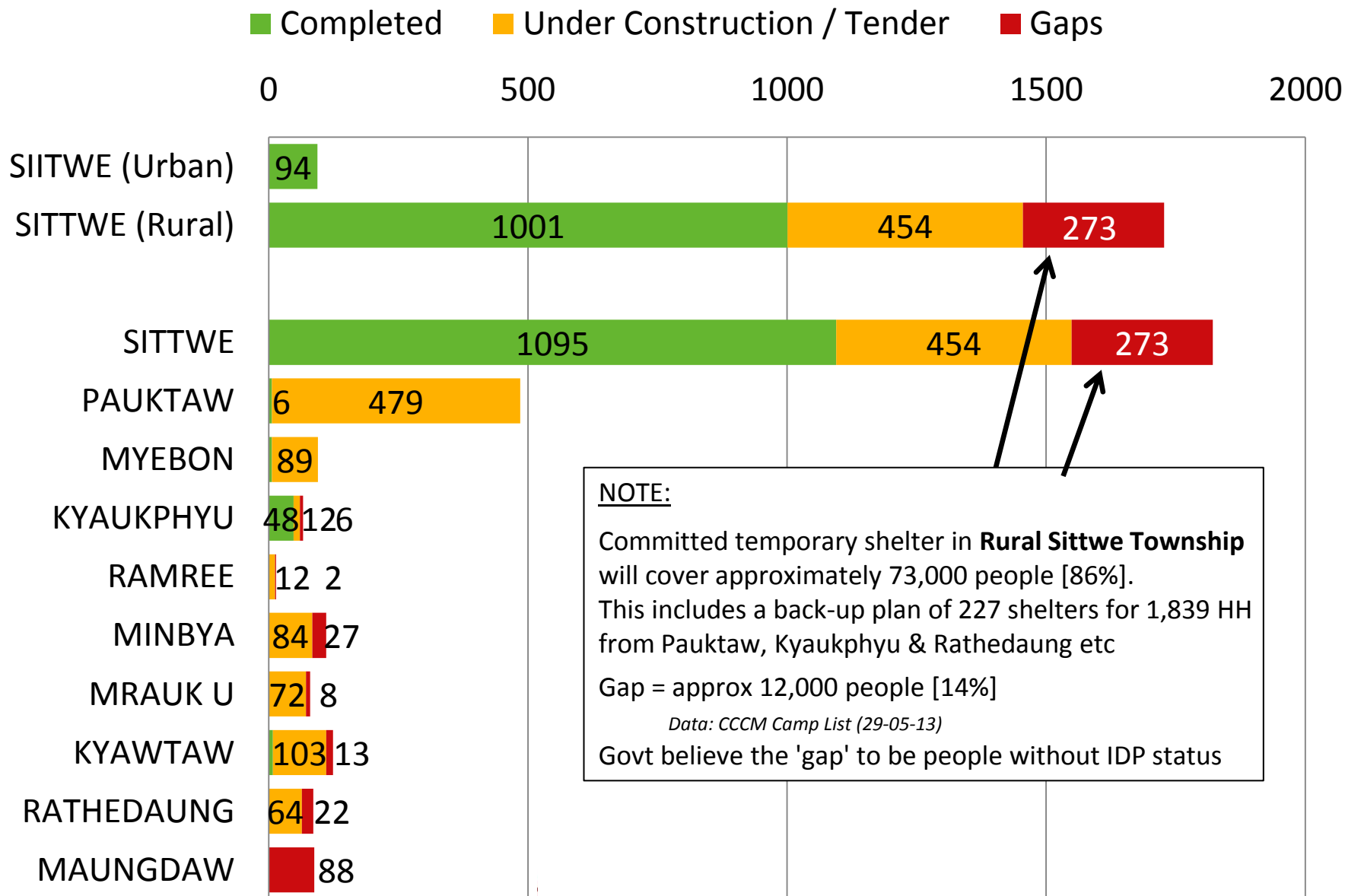

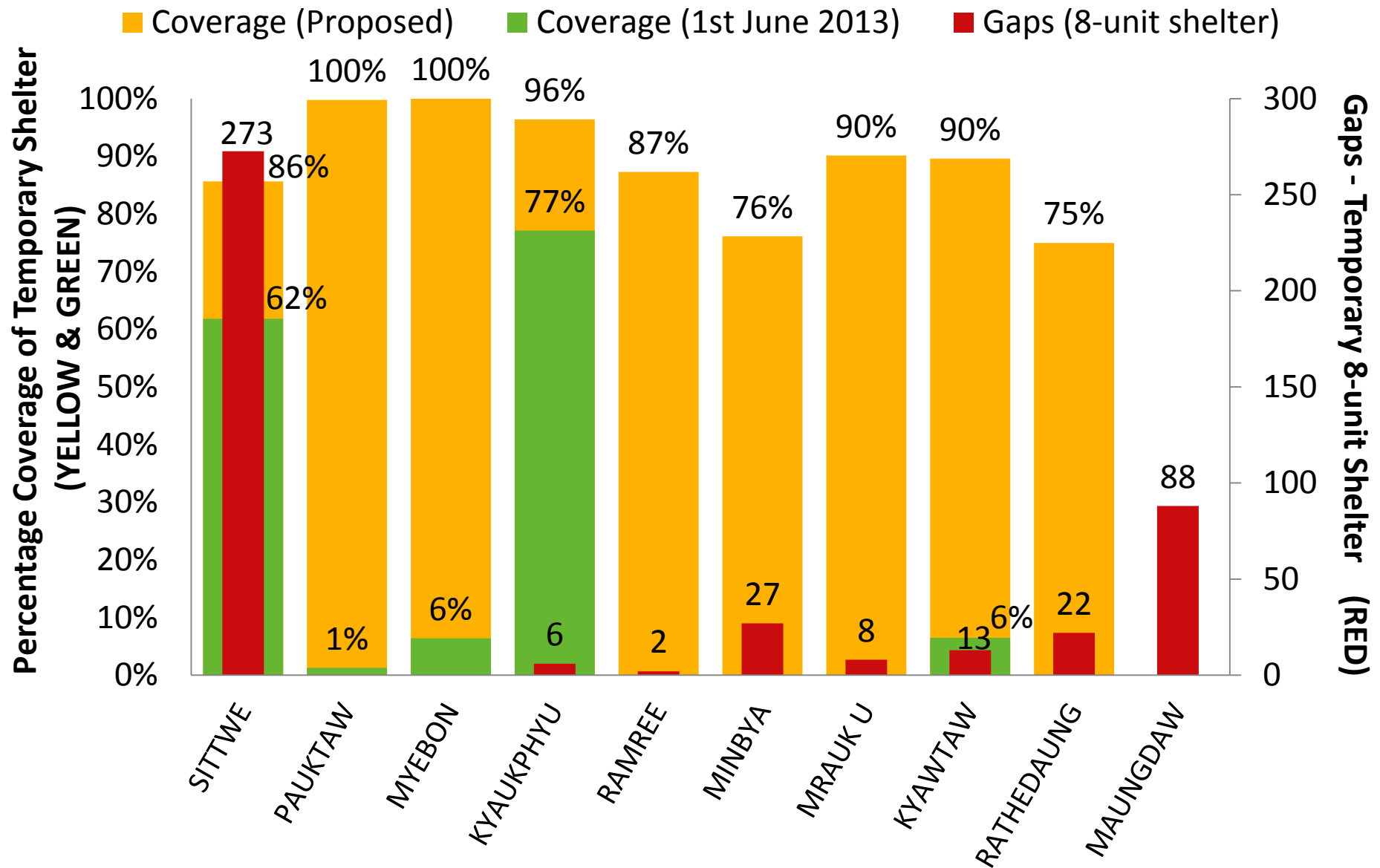
Temporary Shelter Construction in Rakhine State by Agency (1st June 2013)

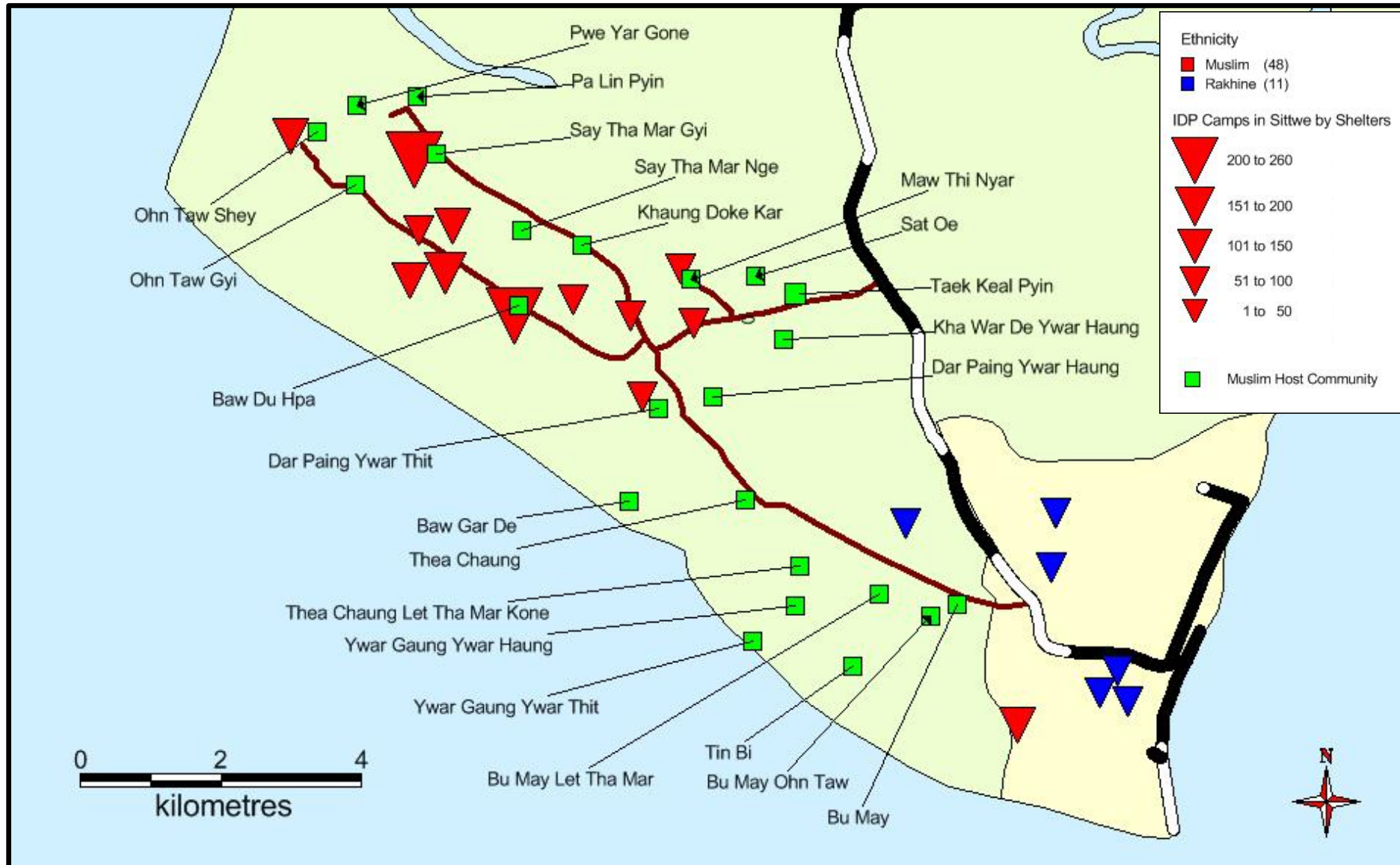


Coverage (GREEN & YELLOW) and Shelter Gaps (RED) for Temporary Shelter in Rakhine State (1st June 2013)

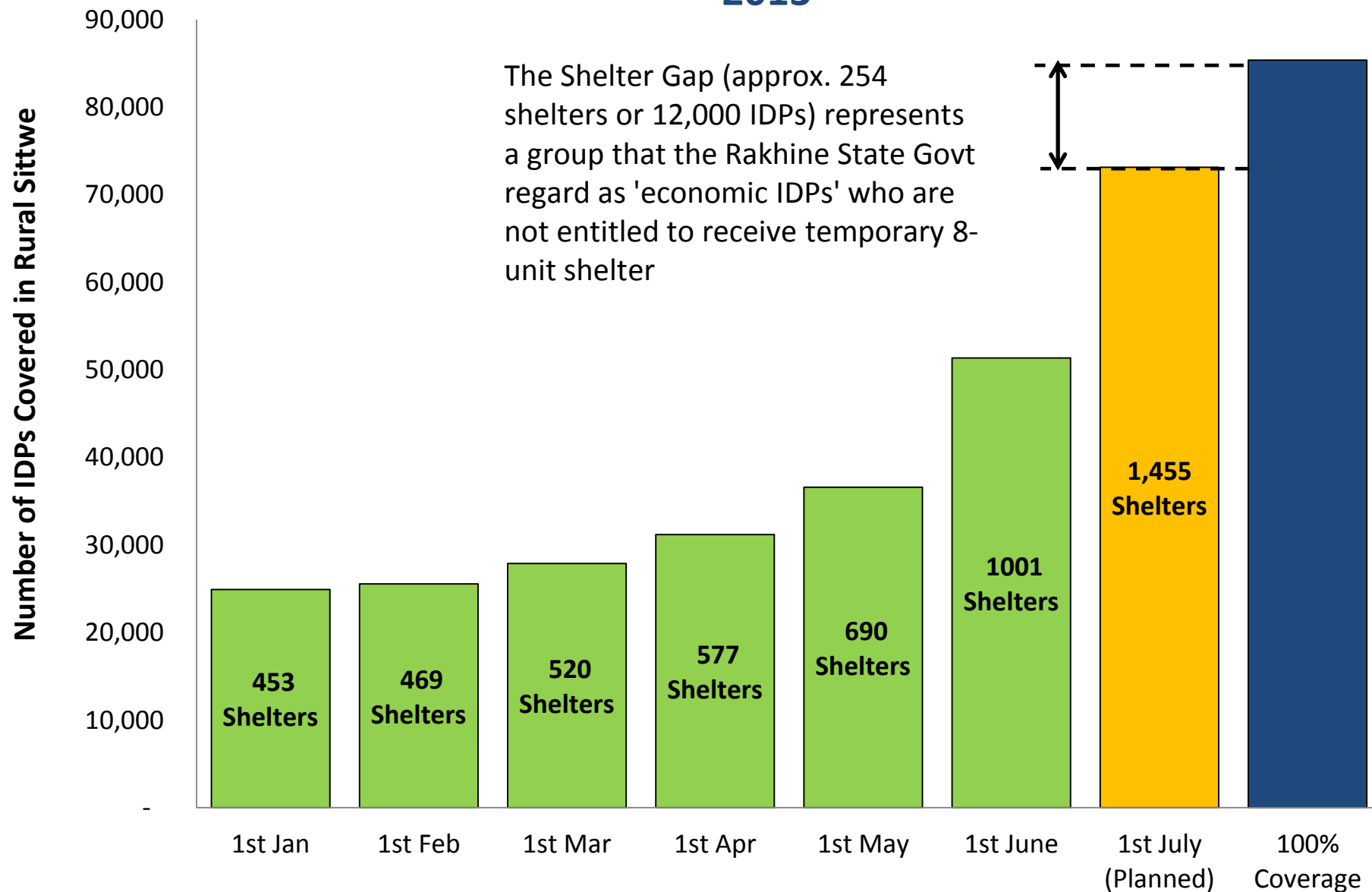

Government Strategy for Identifying IDP Camp Site Locations

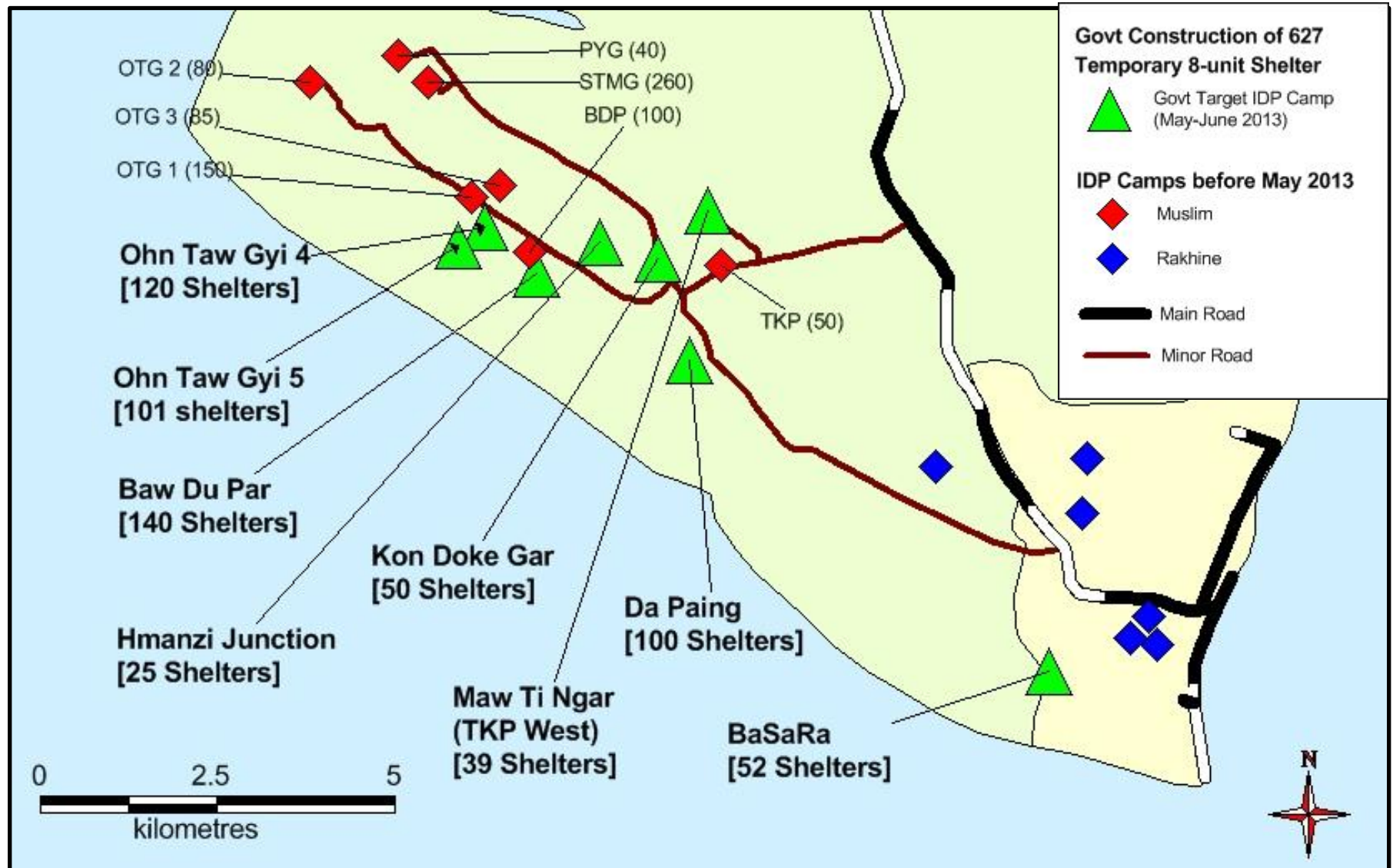
June 2012 – April 2013

- Lack of land and available in rural Sittwe
- Govt strategy to locate IDPs in large camps in remote areas of rural Sittwe e.g. Say Thar Mar Gyi (260 shelters)

May-June 2013

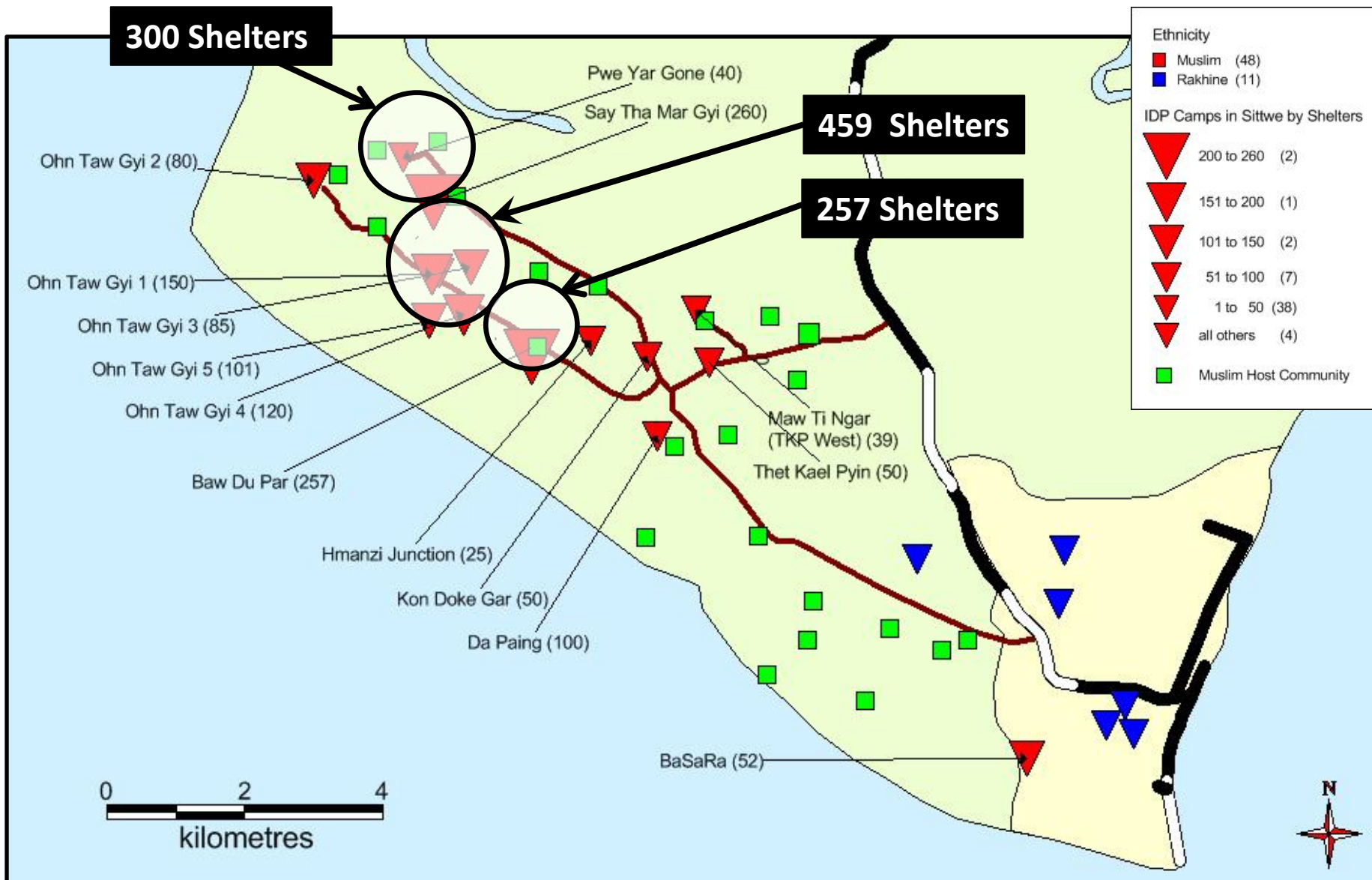
- Plan for 100% coverage in rural Sittwe (except for those to referred to as 'Economic IDPs')
- IDPs to be located in smaller camps around Hmanzi Junction (25-140 shelters)

Government Construction of 627 Temporary Shelters in Rural Sittwe Township (May-June 2013)

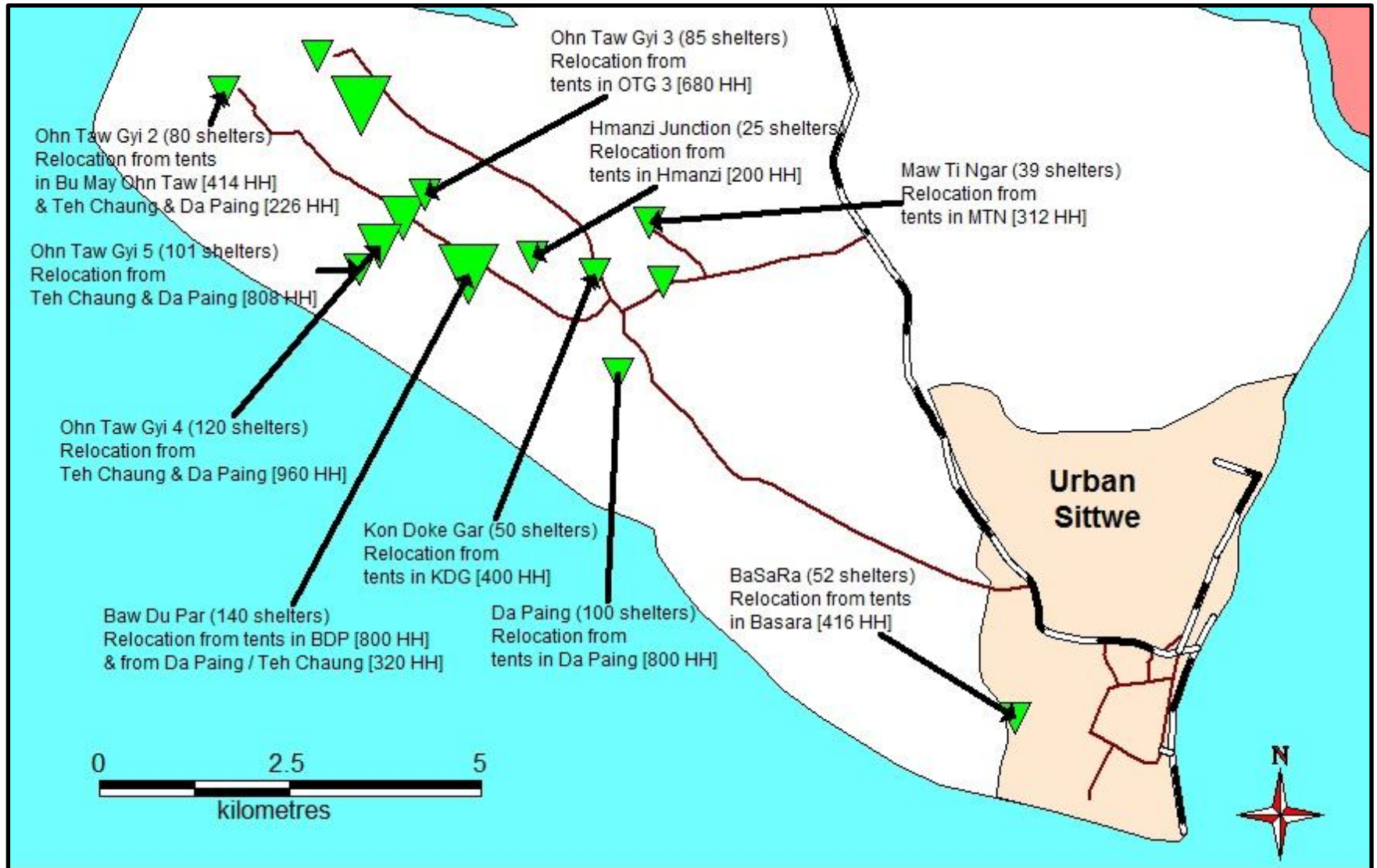


IDP Camps in Rural Sittwe
