KEY FIGURES

At the end of May **5/20** partners (1 UN, 4 INGO) and **6/33** HRP projects are partially funded, (**2.4%** from HRP shelter request).

West Bank/East Jerusalem

Demolition response

Demolished structures: (Mar 2018)	175	of which 46 (26%) are residential, displacing 161 individuals, including 63 children
Donor-funded structures:	28	of which 9 are residential

24 households have received a shelter response in 2018; **5** cases are pending legal counselling.

Demolition or confiscations of all structures have affected **4,861** people during 2018.

The shelter vulnerability assessment for **267** Bedouin and herding communities (**122,582** Individuals) in area C shows that **3,389** shelters need rehabilitation and upgrade to minimum standards.

Gaza

IDP response

Over **3,500** families (about **18,200** individuals) remain internally displaced (IDP) after the 2014 conflict. **1,985** IDP families have received TSCA for the first Quarter in 2018. An **urgent gap in assistance** exists for all IDP families requiring cash support

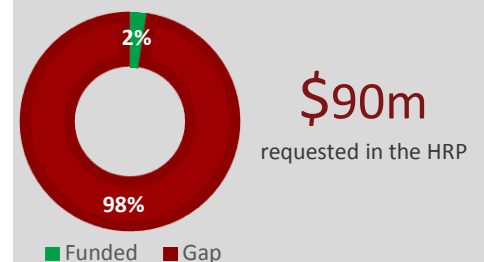
